
Living on Campus

Graduate

- Graduate application, including statement of objectives
- Resume
- Official transcripts
- Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), International English Language Testing System (IELTS), or Duolingo English Test (DET)
- GMAT/GRE scores or test optional
- At least one academic recommendation
- Certificate of Finances and supporting bank statements (upon acceptance)

UNDERGRADUATE

The following are the deadlines and requirements for international undergraduate students.

First Year

- Common Application, including personal essay
- Official transcripts: First marking period grades and mid-year report*
- Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), International English Language Testing System (IELTS), Duolingo English Test (DET), or Pearson Test of English (PTE)
- School report
- SAT/ACT scores or test optional
- At least one letter of recommendation
- Certificate of Finances and supporting bank statements (upon acceptance)

Please note: Photocopied documents will not be accepted.

International undergraduate transfer students must also submit:

- Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), International English Language Testing System (IELTS), Duolingo English Test (DET), or Pearson Test of English (PTE)
- At least one letter of recommendation
- Certificate of Finances and supporting bank statements (upon acceptance)
- SEVIS Record Transfer Verification Form

Early Decision II: January 16
Regular Decision: February 1

Undergraduate Scholarships

All students are considered for merit-based scholarships ranging from \$8,000 to \$40,000 USD per year. Scholarships are based on the application for admission and are renewable for up to four years.

Graduate Scholarships

Graduate international students are eligible for financial support through their home country as well as various on-campus employment opportunities and graduate assistantships. A limited number of merit scholarships may be available for those who qualify. Approximately 30% of international graduate students receive a financial aid award, averaging \$10,000 USD.


